Manuscript Submission Requirements

To ensure the integrity of the double-blind peer review process, authors must prepare and submit **two separate files**:

1. Title Page (Author Information File)

This file must include complete author details:

- Full title of the manuscript
- Full names of all authors
- Institutional affiliations (department, university/organization, city, country)
- Corresponding author's email address (preferably institutional)
- ORCID IDs (if available)
- Optional: academic titles (e.g., Professor, PhD) and acknowledgements

2. Main Manuscript (Anonymous File)

The main manuscript must be **fully anonymized** and must NOT contain any identifying information, including:

- Author names
- Affiliations
- Email addresses
- ORCID IDs
- Acknowledgements
- Any self-identifying references

The manuscript file should include only:

- Title
- Abstract
- Keywords
- Main text
- Tables and figures
- References

⚠ Important Note

Authors must ensure that the manuscript is completely anonymized prior to submission. Failure to remove identifying information may result in delays in the review process.

TITLE OF THE ARTICLE

(Bold, 14–16 pt, centered)

The title should be precise, informative, and clearly reflect the scope, methodology, and contribution of the study. Avoid overly short or generic titles.

Notes for Authors (Delete before submission)

- Use institutional email addresses where possible
- Academic titles (e.g., Professor, PhD) may be included if desired
- Do NOT include social or professional profile links in the manuscript (add them only in the submission system)

ABSTRACT (150–350 words)

The abstract should provide a concise and structured summary of the study, including:

- Background
- Objectives
- Methodology
- Key findings
- Conclusion

Write as a single paragraph. Avoid citations, abbreviations, and undefined acronyms.

1. Introduction

Provide the background, research problem, objectives, and significance of the study. Clearly explain the relevance of the research and identify gaps in existing literature.

Importance of the Study

Explain the theoretical, practical, or policy relevance of the study.

Objectives of the Study

Clearly state the main and specific objectives of the research.

Methodology Overview

Briefly describe the research design, data sources, and analytical approach.

Literature Review

Present a critical review of relevant national and international studies.

2. Theoretical Framework / Main Analysis

Present the conceptual framework, analytical model, or theoretical background of the study.

3. Results and Discussion

Present findings clearly and logically. Interpret results and compare them with previous studies.
